

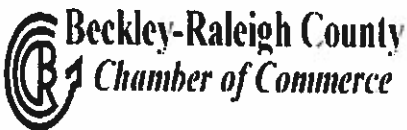

Whereas, the Southern West Virginia counties including Monroe, Summers, Mercer, McDowell, Raleigh, and Wyoming share a diverse history filled with triumphs and challenges. From the popular healing springs of Monroe County to the railroad, timber and coal industries of Wyoming, McDowell, Mercer, Raleigh, and Summers counties, the citizens of West Virginia's southernmost counties have long enjoyed a common bond born of necessity and strengthened through love of the mountain region we all call home; and

Whereas, the six-county region enjoys unrivaled natural beauty that includes majestic mountain ranges, a diverse network of beautiful rivers and streams, temperate-to-mild winters and summers as well as a diverse population base with a shared love for their homes, families and way of life that has been nurtured by generations raised with southern West Virginia values; and

Whereas, the County Commissions of six West Virginia counties named above accept the responsibility of promoting ways of improving the quality of life for our citizens as well as developing better access to the unspoiled natural beauty of our shared region. The County Commissions of Wyoming, McDowell, Mercer, Monroe, Raleigh and Summers counties, therefore seek to develop a six-county non-motorized hiking, kayak, canoe, mountain biking and draisine trail system – with an additional equestrian trail system – to benefit local residents as well as visitors; and

Whereas, the six above-named counties create this Southern West Virginia Non-Motorized Trail Authority under the provisions of West Virginia State Code 20-17-1 through 9, to enjoy certain benefits afforded to trail authorities statewide. In addition, the Southern West Virginia Non-Motorized Trail Authority pledges to develop a system that provides an alternative – not a competition – to the region's state-maintained All-Terrain Vehicle Hatfield-McCoy Trail System; and


Whereas, by developing a non-motorized trail system on abandoned logging, coal haulage railways and stream-side trails, the united counties can promote healthy activities for citizens and guests while embracing a commitment to environmental stewardship of our common natural resources.

WHEREAS, it is further the desire of the Raleigh County Commission to purchase a micro-cut scanner to improve the disposition of election material pursuant to the retention schedule;

WHEREAS, the financial assistance of the West Virginia Records Management and Preservation Board is essential to implement the proposed Raleigh County Records Management Projects; Raleigh County will be entitled to grant money available totaling up to ninety percent (90%) of the amount requested. The Commission being responsible for the remaining ten percent (10%).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: the Raleigh County Commission of Raleigh County, West Virginia, authorizes its County Clerk to file an application for West Virginia Management and Preservation Grant funds, including all understanding and assurance therein, and further directs said County Clerk to act as the official representative of the Raleigh County Commission to provide such additional information as may be required.


