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ESTATE OF MADRITH CHAMBERS

Brandon Gray, Attorney for Stephanie Rosario, daughter of Madrith Chambers, deceased, addressed the Commission. Attorney Gray presented information to the Commission to show that his client, Stephanie Rosario is the best choice to serve as the Personal Representative for the Estate of Madrith Chambers, deceased. Mr. Gray presented the Commission with the death certificate of Madrith Chambers and played the 911 call of Phillip Bennett. Mr. Gray claimed Patrick Bennett, son of Madrith Chambers, cannot serve as Personal Representative for the Estate of Ms. Chambers due to conflict of interest and that Mr. Bennett presented errant information on the death certificate and is not trusted to serve as the Personal Representative of the Estate of Ms. Chambers.

Robert Dunlap, Attorney for Patrick Bennett, son of Madrith Chambers, deceased, also addressed the Commission. Mr. Dunlap informed the Commission Ms. Chambers had trusted her son Patrick to serve as her Power of Attorney, co-owner of bank accounts and mortgage and primary caregiver and he can be trusted to serve as the Personal Representative for Ms. Chambers estate. Mr. Dunlap informed the Commission that Patrick Bennett has been bonded to serve.

Stephanie Rosario addressed the Commission. She stated she has an unexecuted copy of the Will naming her to serve as the Executrix. Ms. Rosario states Patrick Bennett has the contract for a headstone that she paid \$7,013 for and Mr. Bennett will not give her the contract. Ms. Rosario informed the Commission she will reside in the area as long as need to perform the duties as personal representative.

All the children of Ms. Chambers were in attendance. Gregory Bennett, Patrick Bennett, Sharri Chambers, Jennifer Chambers and Stephanie Rosario.




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
